Farmers Feeding Florida, our product recovery and distribution program, has recovered over 374 million pounds of Florida-grown produce over eight years. This direct investment from the Florida legislature supports our state's agriculture industry while getting that Florida-fresh product to those who need it most. Feeding Florida has recently established partnerships with industry leaders and associations to recover Florida protein and dairy products as well.

Florida Nutrition Ed

Florida Nutrition Ed is an evidencebased program that helps people make their SNAP dollars stretch and lead physically active lifestyles and teaches them how to shop for and cook healthy meals. Feeding Florida's network of food banks across the state work with individuals and families daily

and families daily, helping them find access to resources and offering these valuable nutrition education classes in all 67 counties.

Fresh Access Bucks

Fresh Access Bucks, our USDA-funded nutrition incentive program, increases access and affordability of fresh, Florida-grown produce for food-insecure Floridians at farmers markets, produce stands, CSAs, mobile markets, and community grocery stores.
